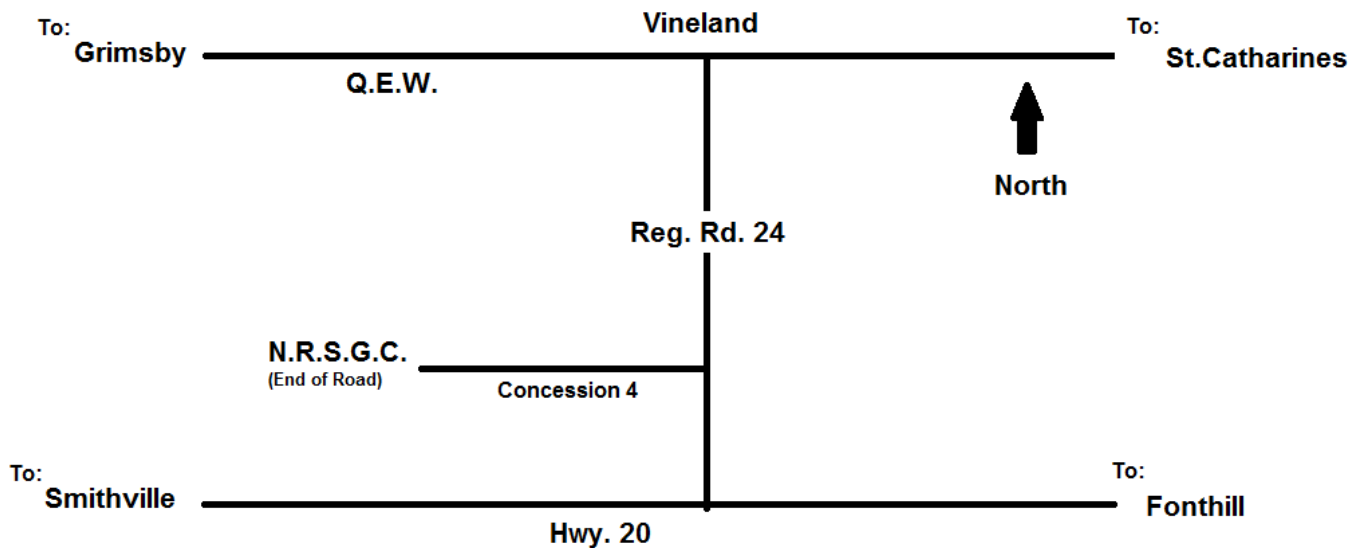

GENERAL INFORMATION

Registration: Registration will begin at 5:00 pm, Thursday, August 2, 2018 and will remain open during range hours.

Range Hours: Shooting is only permitted during range hours.

Friday, August 3	8:30 am to 5:30 pm
Saturday, August 4	8:30 am to 5:30 pm
Sunday, August 5	8:30 am to 5:30 pm
Monday, August 6	8:30 am to approximately 12:00 noon (Soper Event ONLY)

Relays: Time limit for all matches except Rest matches will be one (1) thirty minute relay. All Rest matches (Bench, Log, Buffalo) are allowed two consecutive thirty minutes relays.

Soper event: You may pre-register any time the registration booth is open & pick up your targets on Monday morning. Targets for the Soper match will also be sold Monday, August 6 from 8:00 am to 8:30 am only.

Program changes and /or announcements will be posted on the bulletin board by the target desk.

It is the competitors' responsibility to see that their targets are marked with the proper match and competitor number. Competitors are responsible for the purchasing, care of, and posting correct targets for individual matches. Check score sheet for the proper scoring and posting of individual match scores. Targets must be posted in the upright vertical position, as issued and unaltered in all matches.

Sighting targets are allowed in all matches except those indicated in the program & may be purchased for \$1.00 each.

All competitors are asked to score their targets before placing them in the scoring bin. All targets that are contending for prizes will be re-scored. Targets may be claimed at the conclusion of the awards presentation.

All official match targets must be handed in. If you do not want your actual score posted, mark TMS on your target and hand it in.

Protest period for Match and Aggregate targets ends Monday at 10:00 am; and Monday at 1:00 pm for Soper targets.

No official targets for matches other than the Soper Event will be scored after Sunday evening.

Unauthorized use of the range facility is prohibited. No unauthorized shooting after the last relay of the day. Permission to use the range is the responsibility of the owner/owners.

ONTARIO MUZZLE LOADING ASSOCIATION RULE HIGHLIGHTS

A complete set of rules is available for reference at the Registration desk. A qualified Range Officer will be on duty whenever the range is open, as well as Block Officers on pistol and primitive ranges.

1. Only members of the Ontario Muzzle Loading Association are entitled to compete in these Provincial matches. Memberships are available at the shoot & must be taken prior to purchasing & posting of targets.
2. Junior shooters are to be accompanied by & under direct supervision of an adult member of the OMLA at all times while on the firing line.
3. All matches are patched round ball unless otherwise noted. BLACK POWDER is the only propellant allowed. No duplex loading.
4. Cross stick matches are to be shot using range-supplied cross sticks only. These are to remain unaltered.
5. Competitors are required to supply their own shooting benches. They may also supply their own log and/ or chunk. Logs may be blocked in such a fashion as to prevent free rolling.
6. Flintlock shooters: Flint shields are required at all times and on all ranges. (Handgun, rifle, and primitive).
7. Rifles used to compete in matches subject to weight restrictions must be weighed prior to the shooting of those matches. Failure to comply may result in disqualification of the targets concerned. Weight stickers must remain on the rifle for the duration of the shoot.
8. All muskets must be inspected for as issue sights and a minimum trigger pull of 3 pounds prior to the shooting of matches. Stickers will be attached to indicate acceptable compliance.
9. Consult the program for more detailed restrictions re: weights, sights, posting yardage, target configuration.
10. Consult the Range Officer prior to posting damaged targets.
11. Targets are to remain posted in the frames for only the time period allotted for that match. Exceptions are made for unforeseen circumstances as described in the O.M.L.A. rule book. Consult the Range Officer immediately upon having the problem occur.
12. Targets that are difficult to score or damaged in any way should be left on the posting board for the Range Officer and Scoring Officer to rule upon.
13. LISTEN TO AND OBEY ALL COMMANDS AND INSTRUCTIONS OF THE RANGE OFFICER. DO NOT CROSS FIRING LINE WITHOUT HIS PERMISSION.

Cease fire	DO NOT SHOOT
Any hot ones?	Any loaded rifle or pistol?
Put in the bank or dump your rifle	Fire shot into bank ONLY, not on target
Bench all rifles	Place unloaded rifle against bench & do not handle
Post & pull your target	Cross firing line & change targets
Range is open	Rifles may be handled & loaded. DO NOT cross firing line
14. **Firing after the Range Officer has called a cease fire may result in the match target being disqualified & the competitor being expelled from the firing line.** If your gun is loaded at the time the cease fire is called, the Range Officer will give permission to unload your gun in a safe manner. Indicate that your firearm is loaded when the Range Officer asks “Any hot ones.”
15. No smoking or fire of any kind on the firing line or near powder or supplies.
16. No firearm will be loaded or caps snapped until the command “Commence Loading”. Guns will be carried muzzle up between loading benches & firing line with the muzzle above the shooter’s head. Guns will be held in horizontal position only at the firing line, pointing down range.
17. No open powder containers on the firing line or loading benches. Powder must be poured into the gun with a powder measure, not from the container.
18. No blowing down gun barrel to clear obstruction.
19. No firearm will be capped or primed except at the firing line & no firearm will be removed from the range while loaded.
20. Clearing misfires: Extreme caution must be used including reasonable care to inform neighbouring shooters. The breeching of a firearm or pulling of a bullet must be done in such a manner that there is no danger to persons or property. The use of a CO2 ball discharger is highly recommended.
21. Safety glasses and hearing protection are recommended, but not mandatory.
22. The use of or impairment from intoxicating beverages and/or drugs on the firing line will not be permitted.
23. Board members must be current members of the O.M.L.A. Only Board members may attend Board meeting.

SOPER EVENT

The Soper Event is named after Philo Soper, a 18th century gun maker from London, Ontario. The first Soper Event was held in 1980 in each of 5 regions of Ontario on different dates. In 1981, this match was shot at the Provincials in its present form. Past winners:

*No sighting shots are permitted in any of the 5 separate matches.

*Fouling shots will be permitted prior to the first relay and will be allowed only in the area indicated by the Range Officer.

*Target posting at the direction of the Range Officer.

*Equipment may not be moved during a relay. Time will be given to set up equipment.
